DUAL MEMBERSHIP POLICY

the Montpelier Elks Country Club Golf Committee offers a membership category known as a "Dual Membership" at a reduced rate as part of MECC's annual membership choices. The purpose of this policy is to clarify eligibility for Dual Membership.

A Dual Membership is available to an individual who holds a fully paid membership (other than a Dual Membership or equivalent) at another Vermont golf club during the golf season in which application for the Dual Membership is made. An applicant for a Dual Membership at MECC shall provide satisfactory evidence of his/her membership status at such other Vermont golf club. Upon request, the applicant shall authorize MECC's Pro Shop Manager to confirm his/her membership status with the management of the other golf club.

Any individual who works at another resort or golf course and receives a complimentary golf membership or "privileges of the course" as part of their employment package does not qualify for Dual Membership status at MECC under this policy.

The Golf Committee retains the right to set the price for a Dual Membership prior to the start of the golf season, and to adjust that price in subsequent seasons. The Golf Committee also reserves the right to terminate and no longer offer Dual Memberships in a subsequent golf season at its sole discretion.

This policy shall be effective from the date of approval by the Golf Committee.
